Knowing Old Havana and its people...

- After your lunch you can visit La Plaza del Cristo and also visit "Clandestina" 99% diseño cubano: Clandestina is a brand of Cuban design. A platform through which utilitarian design made in Cuba is commercialized. Graphic and industrial design, textile or digital design; any support serves to contain the new aesthetic constructions of young designers.
- In this street (Teniente Rey) you can see different schools of crafts, a workshop of carpenters, schools, pharmacies, if you wish you can go through the Museum of Pharmacy.

- Also in the Plaza Vieja you can enjoy a colonial atmosphere, semicircular arches, cobbled streets, the fountain in the center of the square.
- You can visit the Plaza San Francisco de Asís.
- Visit La Marca (is considered an alternative cultural institution that blends the art of tattooing with other visual arts, theatre, dance, literature, graphic design and music, with a focus on community outreach and culture for development and gender equality. The art gallery showcases bi-monthly exhibits and performances from new artists...
- You can visit the Plaza de Armas (Palacio de los Capitanes Generales, Castillo de la Real Fuerza, Palacio del segundo Cabo, templete...) and see the sellers of books and antiques, people connected to the internet (something very common in our parks, as there are wifi zones, this is where the Cuban family navigates virtually).
- Finally, do not miss the Plaza de la Catedral, enjoy the architecture of the place, its people and if you want, take a mojito in the Bodeguita del Medio.



Plaza del Cristo

Plaza del Cristo Square is located on the western side of Old Havana, a bit further from the old city. It has also been restored by the Havana Historian's Office.

It is worth visiting the 1732 Iglesia del Santo Cristo del Buen Viaje Church. It has recently been partly restored, and from it its stained glass windows and brightly colored ceiling stand out.

The Plaza del Cristo Square is an ideal place if you want to get far from touristy areas and to witness what real Cuban life is like.

Pharmacy Museum Habanera. Intended to show the history of pharmacies in Havana and the future of pharmaceutical science in Cuba. It also shows archaeological evidences related to the subject, found through the excavations carried out by the Archeology Cabinet in habaneras houses, like numerous flasks found in the Historical Center, some even with the remains of the medications contained, the data of the marketer and the city of origin.
